Marshfield Community Theatre is excited to produce Hello, Dolly! this summer! This show will be directed by David DePriest.

MCT will be holding auditions for Hello, Dolly! on April 24 and 25 at 7 p.m. in the MCT Rehearsal Building at 430 McNabb Road, Marshfield, MO. The show will run June 22-24 at 7 p.m. and June 25 at 3 p.m. If needed, there will be callbacks on Wednesday, April 26 at 7 p.m.

We're looking for at least 20 performers of all ages. The audition will consist of a musical audition, a dance audition and cold readings from the show.

What to prepare:

Everyone should prepare a memorized musical selection no longer than 1 minute in length in a similar style to the show. Please bring sheet music with you for our accompanist.

What to do before your audition:

Please fill out our online audition form and then bring the following with you to your audition:

- A list of potential conflicts for May 1-June 25
- A headshot to be kept with your audition form
- Clothing you can comfortably move in, with closed-toe shoes
- A willingness to step outside of the box and try new things

- Barnaby Tucker an assistant to Cornelius, 17 years old
- **Ambrose Kemper** a young artist seeking to marry Ermengarde

Show Synopsis:

This musical adaptation of Thornton Wilder's hit play *The Matchmaker* bursts with humor, romance, energetic dance and some of the greatest songs in musical theatre history. The romantic and comic exploits of Dolly Gallagher-Levi, turn-of-the-century matchmaker and "woman who arranges things," are certain to thrill and entertain audiences again and again.

Hello, Dolly! premiered on Broadway on January 16, 1964 at the St. James Theatre. Opening with Carol Channing in the title role, the show ultimately played for 2,844 performances, making it – at the time – the longest-running Broadway musical in history. The West End production ran for 794 performances at London's Drury Lane Theatre. The musical has been revived several times on Broadway, most recently in 2017, starring Bette Midler as Dolly Levi.
